ShortCuts

Windows key/Alt+F1: Switch between overview and desktop

Alt+F2: Pop up command dialog (r, rt, lg)

Alt+Tab/Alt+Shift+Tab: Pop up application switcher

Alt+[key above Tab]: Switch between windows of the same application in Alt+Tab

Ctrl+Alt+Tab: Pop up accessibility switcher

Ctrl+Shift+Alt+R: Start and end screencast recording

Ctrl+Alt+Up/Down arrow: Switch between workspaces

Ctrl+Alt+Shift+Up/Down arrow: Move the current window to a different workspace
