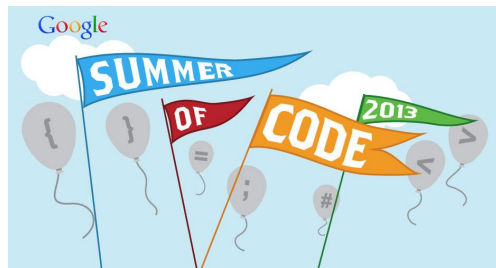

Open links to web and email addresses.

Use Find
Search the *Terminal* output.

Save contents
Save *Terminal* output to a file.

Customize appearance

Change cursor
Select different cursor style

Fullscreen session
Enable fullscreen mode

Change font and style
Use system fonts or choose a custom font for your terminal.

Terminal sizes
Change the *Terminal* window size
